MBPP Roadmap

1 year

MBPP students will then complete 1-year (3 quarters) of undergraduate business courses at UCR's School of Business.

3 years

An MBPP candidate will have completed 3 years of undergraduate study at their home university.

1 or 2 years

After completing their 1-year of undergraduate academic study at UCR and successfully meeting minimum graduate program entrance requirements, MBPP students will be eligible to apply for advanced graduate study at UCR or any university in the world.

Prerequisites

- Complete 3 years of study in degree program at your home university
- English Proficiency: TOEFL 550 PBT, iBT 80, IELTS 6.5, Duolingo 100, CET-4 500 or CET-6 460
- Competitive GPA in undergraduate program
